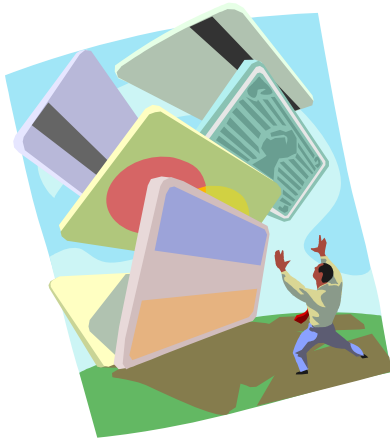


Summer Financial Literacy at the Library
